



## CERTIFICATION FOR APPLICANTS TO KIRON OPEN HIGHER EDUCATION

Kiron Open Higher Education is a social start-up supporting access to higher education for refugees, asylum seekers, internally displaced persons and underserved communities to build a more inclusive society.

Kiron accepts as students people who come from a country in a situation of armed conflict, political instability or natural disaster, or those who have to flee because their life is endangered.

If you fulfil those requirements, you can register with Kiron and will need to upload a document proving that you are a refugee, asylum seeker or internally displaced person. If you do not have any official documentation, please fill out the certification document below and have it signed by a representative at an NGO, a government institution or other relevant organisation. Examples of representatives at institutions: Social workers, counsellors, legal consultants or camp managers (for example, if you are living in a refugee camp or emergency accommodation).
